

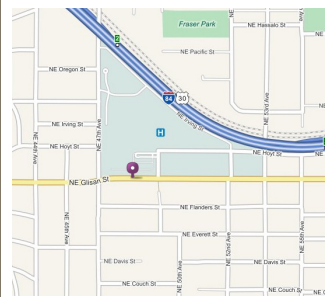
## Brain Tumor Support Group
